'EYE am special' designing unique prosthetic eyes



This fun, open ended activity gives children the opportunity to talk about prosthetic eyes and get creative designing their own pretend prosthetic eyes using art materials such as markers and paints on paper, ping pong balls and rocks.

This activity fosters fun and the creation of not only realistic eyes, but also interesting and new ideas for fun, colourful special eyes with different images – the possibilities are endless!

Kids can share their prosthetic creations and how they see themselves and prosthetic eyes as a way to be an individual and within their greater world. We will have fun exploring what makes each of us unique, and discuss their ideas, fostering and creating opportunity for sharing through creative conversation and creative arts.

You Will Need:

- Print outs of our blank EYE template or plain paper
- Or you can use small smooth rocks, pebbles or ping pong balls of any colour.
- Markers, crayons, pens, paint
- Stickers
- Collage materials of a variety of images of interest (fave sports team, animals, seasonal images, nature etc....)
- Glue or glue stick
